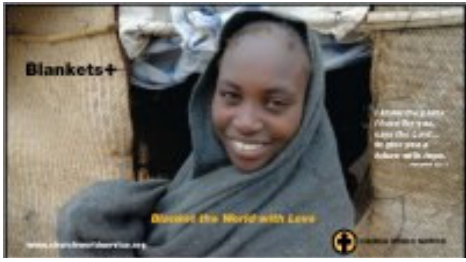

**INSTALLATION SERVICE FOR OFFICERS OF
FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH, NARROWS**

Sunday, January 10, 2010

Minister: We gather today to install the officers of First Christian Church. We ask God's blessing upon them and our common ministries and pledge ourselves to journey together into the future God has for us. We are called to be one people in Christ Jesus; to do justice, to love kindly and walk humbly before God.

People: We hear this call and covenant to work together to overcome the brokenness with the body of Christ and to bind up the wounds of pain and suffering in the world.

Minister: There are a variety of gifts, but one Spirit. Let us offer our differing gifts to the one ministry of Jesus Christ.

People: We covenant to work in a spirit of trust and faithfulness to build up the realm of God on this earth.

Minister: We bring a legacy of service, study and fellowship and covenant to help empower this church for new tasks of ministry.

People: Ministry is one with the whole people of God. We covenant to share fully in our ministries and to uphold one another in love and care.

Minister: In Christ there is neither young or old, male or female, slave or free, but we are all one in Christ Jesus. We covenant to help create a future of promise and joy in this new year of ministry.

People: We covenant our prayers and support to work together to attain a greater wholeness in our congregation.

Minister: The Spirit is poured out upon us and anoints us to bring good news to the poor, release to the captives, sight to the blind, to bind up the wounds of the broken hearted, and to proclaim God's jubilee.

Each of you officers have been elected by this congregation to serve God and this congregation in your particular office. Will you accept this call?

Officers: With the help of God, and the support of this congregation, I accept this call to be a servant and an officer among many to uphold the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Minister: You have been chosen as officers of First Christians Church, Narrows, to serve God and God's church and God's people.

I require and charge each of you to remember that loyalty alone to "Jesus Christ as Lord" will sustain you as you undertake the responsibility of your office this year. You

have been selected by your fellow church members to be officers of our church. Your election indicates that the members of this church recognize your qualities for leadership. They expect you to give real leadership in your particular office. It's an honor to be chosen but the acceptance brings with it sincere responsibilities. From now on, you will be expected to work together as a team under the guidance of Jesus Christ. You will be expected to serve the best interests of our Lord, and of those of our church. In every decision you make you will need to consider whether your action benefits our church and advances the cause of Christ.

As an officer of our church, you will be expected to acknowledge Jesus as your Lord, both privately and publicly. Will you strive to hold before you at all times the need to model your life by His life and to make your total life a witness to Him?

Officers: We will, with the help of Christ, our leader.

Minister: As an officer of our church you will need to set an example, so that others will know that you are willing to do whatever you can to support and promote our church. Are you willing to do all you can to support our church by working with others?

Officers: We will strive to support and promote our church to the best of our abilities, Christ being our Leader.

Minister: Will you, as an officer, put this responsibility you now assume as a priority with your time?

Officers: In accepting my office, I also accept the responsibility it involves.

Minister: As a token of your commitment to God and Jesus and our church, please light your candles from the candle on the communion table. As you light your candles, I ask you to remember we are called to carry the light of Christ into the world. Your candle reminds you that as a Christian and as an officer of this church, you will carry the light of Christ everyday. Please take your candle home with you and put it in a place where it will remind you daily about your commitment to God and to our church.

Minister: To the rest of you of this congregation, I ask: have you elected these people to serve as officers of First Christian Church?

People: Yes, we have.

Minister: Do you covenant with these officers to pray for them and support them as they seek to fulfill the responsibilities of their office?

People: By the grace of the living God, we so covenant.

Minister: To you officers of First Christian Church, Narrows, I say that you are duly installed as an elder, a deacon, a deaconesses, a junior deacon or deaconess, a trustee, a general board officer, or a department chairman.
